Livestock (goats, chickens, pigs):

Daily chores:

- AM/PM feeding and watering
- Milking goats
- Moving electric fencing
- Observing and reporting general health/well-being

Weekly:

- Thoroughly cleaning and bedding pens
- Cheese making

- Animal processing- slaughtering, butchering, storing

This category is a large responsibility and the rest of the staff will participate in these daily chores, but we strive to train a single person to have oversight and to do the majority of the work to help lighten our load.

Orchard:

- Thinning the crop (May-June)

- Sorting fruit for sales (August-October)
- Packing shed organization
- Organizing the walk-in refrigerator- lifting 40 lb. apple boxes, using a pallet jack for pallets of boxes
- Daily irrigation pipe move
